# G.S.R. PREAMBLE

We are the General Service Representatives.

We are the link in the chain of communication for our groups with the General Service Conference and the world of A.A.

We realize the ultimate authority is a loving God as he may express Himself in our Group Conscience.

As trusted servants, our job is to bring information to our groups in order that they can reach an informed group conscience.

In passing along this group conscience, we are helping to maintain the unity and strength so vital to our fellowship.

Let us, therefore, Have the patience and tolerance to listen while others share, The courage to speak up when we have something to share, And the wisdom to do what is right for our group and A.A. as a whole.

## TRADITION TWELVE LONG FORM

And finally, we of Alcoholics Anonymous believe that the principle of anonymity has an immense spiritual significance. It reminds us that we are to place principles before personalities; that we are actually to practice a genuine humility. This to the end that our great blessings may never spoil us; that we shall forever live in thankful contemplation of Him who presides over us all.

Every service responsibility should be matched by an equal service authority – the scope of such authority to be always well-defined whether by tradition, by resolution, by specific job description or by appropriate charters and bylaws.

# WHO CAN VOTE?

(*AREA HANDBOOK* SECT. 8.4 [PG. 21])

The voting membership of the Southern Illinois Area General Service Assembly is composed of the following persons: Area Chair, Alternate Area Chair, Area Delegate, Alternate Area Delegate, Area Treasurer, Area Recording Secretary, Area Registrar, and past Area 21 Delegates as well as past delegates of other areas currently residing in Area 21. Committee Chairs of Archives, CPC, Corrections, Grapevine, GSR Workshop, Literature, PI, Structures and Policy, Treatment, and Webmaster Committees, are also eligible to vote. District Committee Members (DCMs) and the General Service Representatives (GSRs)-or in their absence, their Alternates, are also eligible to vote.

## **SIMPLE MAJORITY OR SUBSTANTIAL UNANIMITY**

SIA Area 21 Handbook Section 8.4: “All important decisions are to be discussion, vote and wherever possible, by substantial unanimity.”

This practice reflects Warranty Four of Concept XII of the 12 Concepts for World Service.

Just before a vote on a motion, the Chair will inform the Assembly whether the motion requires a simple majority to pass or if it requires substantial unanimity to pass.

## MINORITY OPINION

After a vote on a contentious issue, the chair will ask for the minority opinion to be heard. This is done so the Area's action is not in conflict with Concept 5 of the 12 Concepts for World Service: Right of Appeal.

From the *Area 21 SIA Handbook*, Section 8.4.3:

“Once a vote has been conducted, the Chairperson will call for the “Minority Opinion.” At this juncture, all who wish to speak against the vote just taken are invited and encouraged to do so. During Minority Opinion sharing, no member may speak to issue from the standpoint of the majority. Minority opinion is only for the expression of the minority opinion.

After sharing of the Minority Opinion, the Chairperson will ask if anyone who voted with the majority wishes to change their vote. If anyone in the majority has changed their mind on the issue, the Chair will preside over another vote on the motion. If the motion is again passed, the vote stands. If the motion is defeated during the second vote, it is defeated entirely.”

NOTE: the General Service Conference uses a different procedure. It is described in the *A.A. Service Manual 2021-2023 edition*, pg. 166.
